With over half the population of Uganda being under the age of fourteen, much of our future ministry will involve reaching the youth. Currently, we are at 11% of our needed support to get to Uganda. Our goal is to see an average of 1% added to that total every week for 100 weeks which would allow us to be in Uganda permanently in just under two years! As we close the chapter of part-time deputation, we would ask that you pray for these specific requests:

- 1. **The birth of our child**. Abbey is scheduled to be induced on December 10th! We are very excited to welcome a new member of the Turner family very shortly!
- 2. **Full-time deputation**. Beginning on January 20th, we will officially begin full-time deputation. It has been a dream of ours to finally get to this moment in our lives. We are ready to be full-time in the ministry! Please pray with us that we can continue to schedule meetings and press toward our future place of ministry!
- 3. **More Christians to surrender to missions**. Jeremiah wrote in Lamentations, "Mine eye affecteth mine heart..." If we would just look out and see the needs of the people of this world, we would realize that the cause of Christ needs more people to surrender to the area of missions.
