Because I have the equipment, I was able to record several services or participate in live zoom calls for many of the churches at which we had scheduled meetings. By the end of July, we will be able to "hold" virtually fifteen of the seventeen meetings we had left!

In the past few weeks, we have learned of severe flooding that is taking place in several of the western towns in Uganda. One city in particular, Kasese, is the town at which we are planning to begin our first term of ministry. Thousands of Ugandans have been affected by this catastrophe. Crops and homes have been swept away by the raging waters. Please pray with us that the missionaries in that area would be able to minister in whatever way is needed.

We would also ask that you keep these requests in your prayers as well:

- 1. Rescheduling of our survey trip. For many reasons, we are uncertain of a time for which we could reschedule the trip, but God knows. Please pray that we would be able to at least begin planning this trip in the near future.
- 2. Our support level. We added one new supporting church this month which brings our current support level to 94%! Please pray that we would be able to reach our support goal of 100% before linguistics school this August. We are praying for TEN more churches to partner with us.
- **3.** More Christians to surrender to missions. "... The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few;" -Matt. 9:37
