At Bible Baptist Church here in Bowie, the entire month was focused on missions, and we were challenged by fellow missionaries who were able to present their work. Because the doctor is not sure what it is, an outpatient surgery to remove part of or all of the growth is necessary. Please pray for strength as the procedure will require a four week “no-lift” recovery time.

With three months remaining in our school semester, these are some specific prayer requests that we have:

- 1. Our May 2021 survey trip.** We are excited to finally have a tentative date for our survey trip. After our BBTI graduation on May 15<sup>th</sup>, we are praying about a May 18<sup>th</sup> departure. On this trip, we will be looking at specific places where God might have us serve. Please pray for God's direction and leading in the many important decisions we must make in the near future.
- 2. Abbey's health.** Please pray that God would give the doctor's wisdom during Abbey's outpatient surgery later this month and for an easy recovery.
- 3. The US/Canada border to open.** Before moving to Uganda, we have several things that we need to accomplish in Canada with my family and our sending church. Please pray that the borders will open soon.
- 4. More Christians to surrender to missions.** Jeremiah wrote in Lamentations, *“Mine eye affecteth mine heart...”* If Christians would look and see, we would realize the great need that the people around the world have.
