These are some specific prayer requests that we currently have:

1. **The end of the school year.** Even though only six weeks remain, we still have new concepts and information that we are attempting to grasp. Please continue to pray with us as we study these courses.
2. **Our May 2021 survey trip.** We are excited to finally have a date for our trip. Please begin to pray that our COVID tests will come back negative and in a timely manner. All three of us will be required to have negative tests in the United States and in Uganda.
3. **Abbey's CT scan results.** Please pray that her CT scan result will come back clean and that her pain would completely go away.
4. **The US/Canada border to open.** Before moving to Uganda, we have several things that we need to accomplish in Canada with my family and our sending church. Please pray that the borders will open soon.
5. **More Christians to surrender to missions.** Jeremiah wrote in Lamentations, *"Mine eye affecteth mine heart..."* If Christians would look and see, we would realize the great need that the people around the world have.
