This was her first time speaking through an interpreter, and it was quite the experience!

God once again proved His faithfulness by providing all the finances necessary to get this problem fixed. Please pray that this will conclude the major issue with our vehicle and that we will be able to get our Ugandan driver's licenses this month.

Our language teacher continues to grow in the Lord through the discipleship program, and she was able to attend a local Baptist church for the first time a few weeks ago. She also attended the ladies' conference and was encouraged by the singing and teaching.
