I would like to begin our prayer letter by THANKING those who prayed for Robert's wife, Marry. During the first week of September, we were able to have her in our home. Like her husband, she had been heavily influenced by the Pentecostal church, but after a couple hours of explaining and answering questions, we were able to see Marry bow her head and trust Christ as her personal Saviour! This is the thirteenth person to accept Christ since our language teacher, Ms. Lois, got saved in February! What an amazing testimony of what a difference ONE person can make!

In addition to discipleship lessons with Lois every other day during the week, we are also continuing our Rutooro language learning. It has been a challenge to be able to practice what we have learned since there are very few Rutooro speaking people in the capitol; however, God continues to cross our paths with some Batooro people! This past month, we did vocabulary exercises for another eighty words. I am not sure the exact number of words we have learned; but if you count all the numbers we have memorized, it must be in the millions! :P

During this first week of October, we are traveling to Kasese for the first time since moving to Uganda. While in Kasese, we will be looking for a house to rent for the remainder of our first term. Kasese is located in the western part of Uganda about seventy-five minutes from Fort Portal. During our survey trip last May, we believe God called us to eventually establish a New Testament local church in the city of Fort Portal, and we are looking forward to living closer to the city where we will begin our ministry during our second term. Once we move to Kasese, we will be getting some experience in how to minister to village people while working with Missionary Matt Stensaas. We are privileged to have several veteran missionary families here in Uganda from which we can learn!

Please pray for the following requests for the month of October:

- 1. Growth in the lives of new converts. We have many people that have accepted Christ in the last four months. Please pray that these new converts would continue to grow in Christ and that we would be able to balance our time for any extra discipleship lessons that will be needed.
- 2. Preparation to move to Kasese. Please pray that God would lead us to the right person from whom we can rent a home in the western town of Kasese. We are unsure of the exact date for our move. Please pray for wisdom to know the right timing for our family.
