Although she had been diagnosed with a blood clot in the lung, after her passing, spinal cord cancer was discovered as the cause of the blood clots and her death. The family was greatly heartbroken and are still trying to process the unexpected loss of another family member. At the vigil which took place the evening she passed, I had the opportunity to give a brief word of encouragement with Bible verses and a picture of the Gospel. Most of Lois' family is from the city of Fort Portal, and they were delighted to hear that we will be starting a church there during our second term. We are uncertain of the salvation of Ms. Lois' aunt, but she had heard a Gospel presentation from her niece before her death. Being there for the family and attending the vigil was another huge cultural opportunity for me. I was able to spend several hours with the family helping with the dinner and praying with various family members who were in desperate need of comfort. Though this was a difficult time, the family was very appreciative of my presence, and we are praying the Lord would use this as an opportunity to witness to more of Lois' family in the
