1. **Children's Program.** This past month, Abbey had a new high attendance with nineteen children! With school resuming this month, please pray that the children will remain faithful to attending their Wednesday night program.
2. **Pastors' Wives Bible Study.** For almost two months, Abbey has been conducting a one-hour Bible study through WhatsApp for five different Ugandan pastors' wives. Please pray that the group will continue to grow and more pastors' wives will join.
3. **Rwenzori Baptist College Music Class.** I have finished the philosophy portion of the Bible college music class and now Abbey is teaching the music theory section on Monday nights. To our knowledge this is the only "nuts-and-bolts" class for music within our Baptist circles in Uganda. With that in mind, this class is vitally important to the future of Godly music in the country!
4. **Language Learning.** I will continue studying the language of Rutooro with a new language instructor this month. Please pray that God would continue to unlock the various components within the Rutooro language.
5. **Carson's schooling.** Our son has begun his kindergarten year of school! Please pray for Carson to excel in his learning and for Abbey as she monitors his work.
6. **God would grow our Family.** We have been praying that God would allow us to have more children. While in the States, Abbey had an appointment that confirmed it is possible. Please continue to pray with us that God would grant this great desire of our hearts.
7. **More People to Surrender to Worldwide Missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still very great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
