After spending ten days with Abbey's family in Indiana and Mother's Day with each of our moms, we started our travels with a four-day missions conference in Mentor, OH. Since then, we have been in eight churches across three states and one province in Canada. The highlight of our month took place in Welland, Ontario. After the church service, a lady introduced herself in Rutooro, the language we are attempting to learn. She then explained that she had moved from Fort Portal, Uganda, to Canada several years prior and that her children had recently joined her. It was an encouragement and surprise to meet some Batooro people on the other side of the world! Please pray that we will be able to connect with this lady's relatives in Fort Portal when we return to the field. Before leaving Ontario, Abbey was able to attend a Ladies Conference at Faithway Baptist Church. It was a special time of fellowship and learning for her.

One of the highlights of furlough is getting to spend time with family and to share with them what God has been doing in Uganda. At the end of May, we were able to enjoy a day in southwestern Michigan visiting my grandmother. She is eighty years old and still serving God in the bus ministry at her local church. Her passion for souls is contagious and has only increased with age. If God would allow it, we hope that she could visit Uganda someday in the future. The following day, we were able to spend a few hours with my uncle and cousins in Indiana. As time allows, we are relishing every moment possible with our families. After three meetings in Alberta, we will be with my parents in British Columbia for the remainder of June and the first two weeks of July. Additionally, I will have an opportunity to preach at the upcoming Baptist Friends Conference hosted by our sending church in Burnaby, BC.

- 1. Our meetings. This month, we will be visiting twelve churches. Please pray that we will be an encouragement to the churches and challenge those attending to do more for the cause of Christ.
- 2. My father's health. He has another PET scan scheduled for July. The neuropathy in his legs is still causing a tremendous amount of discomfort and pain. Please continue to pray that the specialists would be able to find a solution that could provide some relief for him.
