In Acts chapter eight, we read the fascinating account of God organizing a "divine appointment" between Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch. Though Philip was accomplishing a great work in Samaria and many people were being saved, God knew there was a man in the desert that needed to hear the



Gospel. We had the privilege to encounter one such experience at the Entebbe Airport in April. Rose was returning to North America after visiting her family that lives in Kasese, which is where we live and minister in Uganda. She then told us that she resided in the Lower Mainland, which is where my parents have been serving as missionaries since 2000. Upon arrival in British Columbia last month, we were able to reconnect with Rose, and she began attending our sending church, Anchor Baptist. It was such a blessing to meet another Ugandan living in Canada! Please pray that God would continue to work in her life, and that we

would have the opportunity to build a relationship with her family upon our return to Kasese.

While presenting an update at another church in British Columbia, we met a Ugandan man by the name of Comfort whose family lives in the Mbarara District, about three hours from Kasese. God has opened our eyes on this furlough and has allowed us to meet people from the country that we love. In twenty-five years of living in North America, I never remember meeting a single person from Uganda, but since our return for furlough, we have met three!

Our time with my family in British Columbia is quickly concluding. Carson has thoroughly enjoyed getting to spend a significant amount of time with his Grandpa and Grandma Turner! At the time of this letter being sent, we are still in Canada with one meeting remaining. By the end of July, we will be in the middle of the California heat attending several update meetings with supporting churches. Please pray for the following requests in the month of July:

- 1. Our meetings. This month, we will be visiting ten churches. Please pray that we will be an encouragement to the churches and challenge those attending to do more for the cause of Christ.
- **2. Our safety.** So far, we have driven a little over 9,500 miles. Please pray that our van will have the longevity necessary to drive for the remaining five months of our furlough.
- **3. My father's health**. He has a PET scan scheduled on July 10th. The neuropathy in his legs is still causing a tremendous amount of discomfort and pain. Please continue to pray that the specialists would be able to find a solution that could provide some relief for him.
- **4. More People to Surrender to Worldwide Missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still very great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
