On Tuesday, March 18th, our prayers were answered in the beautiful form of a daughter, Madelyn Kay Turner. She weighed six pounds and thirteen ounces and measured nineteen and a quarter inches long! It has been amazing for our son to witness this incredible answer to prayer! He loves being a big brother, and we are so grateful to the Lord for granting this desire of our hearts. 4. **The future church plant in Fort Portal.** Our prayer is that God would open the necessary doors, prepare the hearts of the people, and give us wisdom as we embark on our first church plant later this year. We are very excited to take this next step and put to action what we have learned in our first term of ministry in Uganda. God will have to be the ONE who enables us to accomplish something great for the cause of Christ!
