With the purchase of return tickets to Uganda, our extended furlough is coming to an end. Madelyn's documents and passport arrived in a much faster time than was expected, and she has already become quite the traveler in her short life. In May, our family made two trips to visit great grandparents in both TN and MI. While in TN, Abbey was able to walk for her master's in education through Crown College, though she still has two courses remaining. When we returned to Greenwood, IN, I was able to speak at the Marion County Jail where **twelve men accepted Christ** as their personal Saviour! Later in the month, we visited my Grandma Bailey in Adrian, MI. She is in her early eighties with some health challenges, but those obstacles have not stopped her from continuing to serve the Lord in the bus ministry, children's ministries, and personal evangelism. Armed with her puppet "Koko," she gives Gospel tracts to everyone who will receive them. God has truly blessed our family with an amazing godly heritage!

July 15th is our day of departure from the States. Once we return to Uganda, our priority is getting updated immigration documents and driver licenses. These must be obtained in Kampala before we make the eight-hour drive back to our home in Kasese. Attempting to get documentation completed in a third world country can be quite an undertaking. Please pray with us that everything we need will be completed in a timely manner so that we can avoid any extra travel with a new baby. Also, we are targeting an October move to Fort Portal, but we must find a new home first. Please pray that the Lord would guide us to a great homeowner and the perfect new home in the city of Fort Portal.

In addition to the ones mentioned above, please pray for the following requests in the month of June:

1. **Preparation for our return to Uganda.** The tickets have been booked, and the packing has begun. Please pray that we remember everything that we will need for this next term of ministry.
2. **Two flights in June.** Our family will return to British Columbia on June 2nd for a week of family time with my parents and fellowship with our sending church, Anchor Baptist. Additionally, Carson and I will be flying to Arizona for Father's Day weekend to present our ministry.
3. **My father's health.** Please continue to keep my dad, Pastor Ben Turner, in your prayers. He is still dealing with neuropathy in both legs and feet and needs miracle healing from the Lord!
4. **Madelyn's development.** In preparation for our move back to Uganda, we are praying that Madelyn's immune system will be strengthened before being introduced to the challenges of living in a third world country.
5. **The future church plant in Fort Portal.** Our prayer is that God would open the necessary doors, prepare the hearts of the people, and give us wisdom as we embark on our first church plant later this year.
6. **More people to surrender to worldwide missions.** While the need for more laborers in North America is still great, we also need more laborers to surrender to be used of God around the world.
