We have begun looking and asking around, and we are trusting the Lord to provide the perfect place at the right time and price.

We are excited about the Christmas season that is quickly approaching. Christmas is one of the biggest holidays in Uganda, and we want to do something special and memorable in Butangwa that will honor the Saviour and reach many with the Gospel. Please pray earnestly for wisdom as we plan. One new friend the Lord has given us is Richard, the manager of one of the largest restaurants here in Fort Portal. I was able to present the Gospel clearly to him this past week, and he listened attentively. He has invited me to attend a special program he and some others have created for a small group of orphans. Please pray that I will be given the opportunity to teach a Bible lesson at the weekly gathering and that many of the children's hearts will be convicted to receive salvation!
