This has been a very difficult month for our family, but we are clinging to the Lord's comfort and faithfulness. In December 2025, we shockingly discovered that Abbey was pregnant. With our history of miscarriages, we chose to wait until the second trimester before sharing the news publicly, trusting God with every step. Sadly, on February 10th, we suffered our third miscarriage, which has left us heartbroken, but grateful for God's grace (**II Cor. 12:9**) sustaining us through the grief. Our family traveled to Kampala for better medical care, where Abbey underwent a successful D&C procedure to ensure her physical recovery. The medical team was kind and professional, and we praise the Lord for providing that help when we needed it most. Please continue to pray for Abbey's ongoing physical healing and especially for emotional and spiritual comfort for all of us as we process this loss.

Amid the sorrow, the Lord has also given us exciting progress in ministry here in Fort Portal. During the last week of February, we signed the rental agreement for Hope Baptist Church with a local high school—such a wonderful provision after months of searching and praying! The space is suitable for services, and we are thankful for this open door. Please pray that God would continue to grant us favor with the head teacher, the class teachers, and even the students at the school. We desire good relationships that reflect Christ's love and open opportunities to share the Gospel, which has already been made possible through this development. We are especially looking ahead to our very first service of Hope Baptist Church on March 22nd—what a milestone it will be! Pray earnestly that the Lord would prepare hearts, bring people from the community, and make this launch a powerful beginning for the work He has called us to in Fort Portal.

- 1. The opening of Hope Baptist Church.** Please pray as we prepare for the first service on Sunday, March 22nd.
- 2. International travel.** Abbey's mother is with us for one more week and her grandparents will be arriving during the second week of March. We are grateful for the time with family, especially after our loss and with the start of HBC-Fort Portal.
- 3. Our family.** Please pray that Abbey's body will continue to heal from the miscarriage. Our son, Carson is in his final sixty days of second grade. Our daughter, Madelyn, will turn one on March 18th. Please pray that God would give me the strength and wisdom needed as I step into the role of "pastor."
- 4. Lhukonzo Baptist Music YouTube Channel.** Please pray that God would give the strength needed to Bro. Mumbere Joshua as he continues to translate and record Godly music in the Lhukonzo language. Feel free to give the channel a "subscribe." So far, we have twenty-seven songs on the channel.
- 5. More people to surrender to worldwide missions.** The need for more laborers to surrender to be used by God around the world is great.
